



EMPLOYABILITY 4: Digital Assignment (INTERMEDIATE)

Title: Volunteering

Focus Skills Development: Self-management/Taking responsibility, Working effectively with other people, Business and customer awareness, Decision-making and Problem-solving, Initiative and enterprise, Communication and Literacy, Numeracy, Using ICT.

Task: Work out how many hours a week you could volunteer; then seek out opportunities in the local community. It could be a local church, mosque, charity shop, sports club, etc. Or it could be a non-governmental organisation (NGO) working with people in crisis.

Time frame: Aim to complete this assignment in around 1 week.

Resource: Seek out a list of local NGOs, charities, churches, mosques and sports clubs.

Self management / taking responsibility	Through volunteering I have developed my skills in time management and taking responsibility for what happens in my community.
Business and customer awareness	I researched local organisations and considered which would be best to volunteer for to develop my professional skills and work experience.
Working effectively with other people	While volunteering I worked with individuals as well as in teams to contribute to the organisational goals.
Decision making and problem solving	My role as a volunteer required me to make decisions and solve problems on several occasions.





Initiative and enterprise	The volunteering experience allowed me to take initiative and to demonstrate enterprise through working with others to create solutions for the target audiences.
Communication and Literacy	My volunteering position called for inter personal communication and literacy as I engaged with clients of the organisation on a regular basis.
Using ICT	In my volunteering activities I had to develop and manage a database for the organisation.
